Deliver pre-2020 commitments, including Doha Amendment. USD100bn annually by 2020








Celebrating 25 years of adaptation under the UNFCCC

During COP 25, the [Adaptation Committee](#) launched its 2019 flagship report on **25 Years of Adaptation Under the UNFCCC**. The report offers an overview of how adaptation has been addressed through the UNFCCC process since the Convention entered into force 25 years ago. The report traces the path of adaptation, from the beginning of the Convention, through important milestones like the Cancun Adaptation Framework and the Paris Agreement. The report offers a glimpse into the future as envisioned by the agreement's governments have put in place to help safeguard the well-being of people and the planet. The report includes descriptions of the relevant institutions, bodies, and mechanisms under the UNFCCC process and the evolving adaptation priorities.
